50 metres past the corner of Owen Rd and Darlington Rd

We will ride the full length of the Heritage Trail from Darlington down to Boya and Bellevue, travel through Swan View and Greenmount to John Forrest, Parkerville, Stoneville, Mount Helena, Sawyers Valley, across Great Eastern Hwy to Mundaring, Mahogany Creek and back to Glen Forrest.

On the way back, we will meet at the rotunda near the corner of Gugeri Street and Jacoby Street, Mundaring to devour the delicious pizzas from Russo's Pizza, Mundaring.
